

School of the Nations Scholarship Program for the School Year 2019-2020

Overview and Process

The School of the Nations is a Baha'i-inspired school located in Taipa, Macau. We are dedicated to nurturing the physical, intellectual, and spiritual development of students, and strive to nurture their capabilities to contribute to the well-being of their families and communities.

Founded in 1988 with an initial cohort of five students, the school has grown into an institution with a vibrant kindergarten and primary division, an expanding middle school, and a secondary school that follows the internationally recognized IGCSE and IB programs.

The school is excited to announce that four scholarships will be made available for the 2019-2020 school year. Two scholarships are available to students with demonstrated financial need entering the school at Primary 1 and two for students entering at Form 1.

Nature of the scholarship

1. The scholarships are available to students entering either Primary 1 or Form 1 in the School of the Nations, Macau (applicable to present and new students).
2. The need-based scholarship covers 50% of the tuition fee.
3. The scholarships may be enjoyed until graduation, provided the awardees continue to demonstrate financial need, maintain the required academic level, and uphold the moral and social standards expected of students at the School of the Nations.

Who may qualify for the scholarship?

1. The awards are open to students who are permanent residents of Macau and who have successfully completed their Kindergarten 3 or Primary 6 year of school.
2. The candidate must demonstrate financial need. (Please see Financial Requirement Letter)
3. The candidate must meet all regular School of the Nations entrance requirements.

Selection of Awardee

After reviewing applications, successful candidates will be requested to attend an assessment day on Saturday, March 9, 2019. Based on all of the information, a decision will be made on which students will be awarded the scholarships.

Responsibilities of the awardee and his/her parent(s) or guardian

1. The parent or guardian must submit truthful and accurate information about their financial situation. The School of the Nations reserves the right to terminate the scholarship if there are misrepresentations in the scholarship application.

2. The awardees must indicate acceptance within one week after notification of the scholarship grant.
3. The parents or guardian of the awardees shall provide for all other needs of the student outside of those stipulated in the scholarship grant including lunches, school uniforms, and other costs related school activities and trips.
4. The awardees shall observe all rules and regulations of the School of the Nations.
5. To maintain their awards, the awardees shall maintain a level of scholastic achievement set by the Scholarship Committee.
6. A yearly evaluation will be made by the Scholarship Committee to determine the financial need of the family and if the awardee is still qualified to continue in the scholarship program for the following year.
